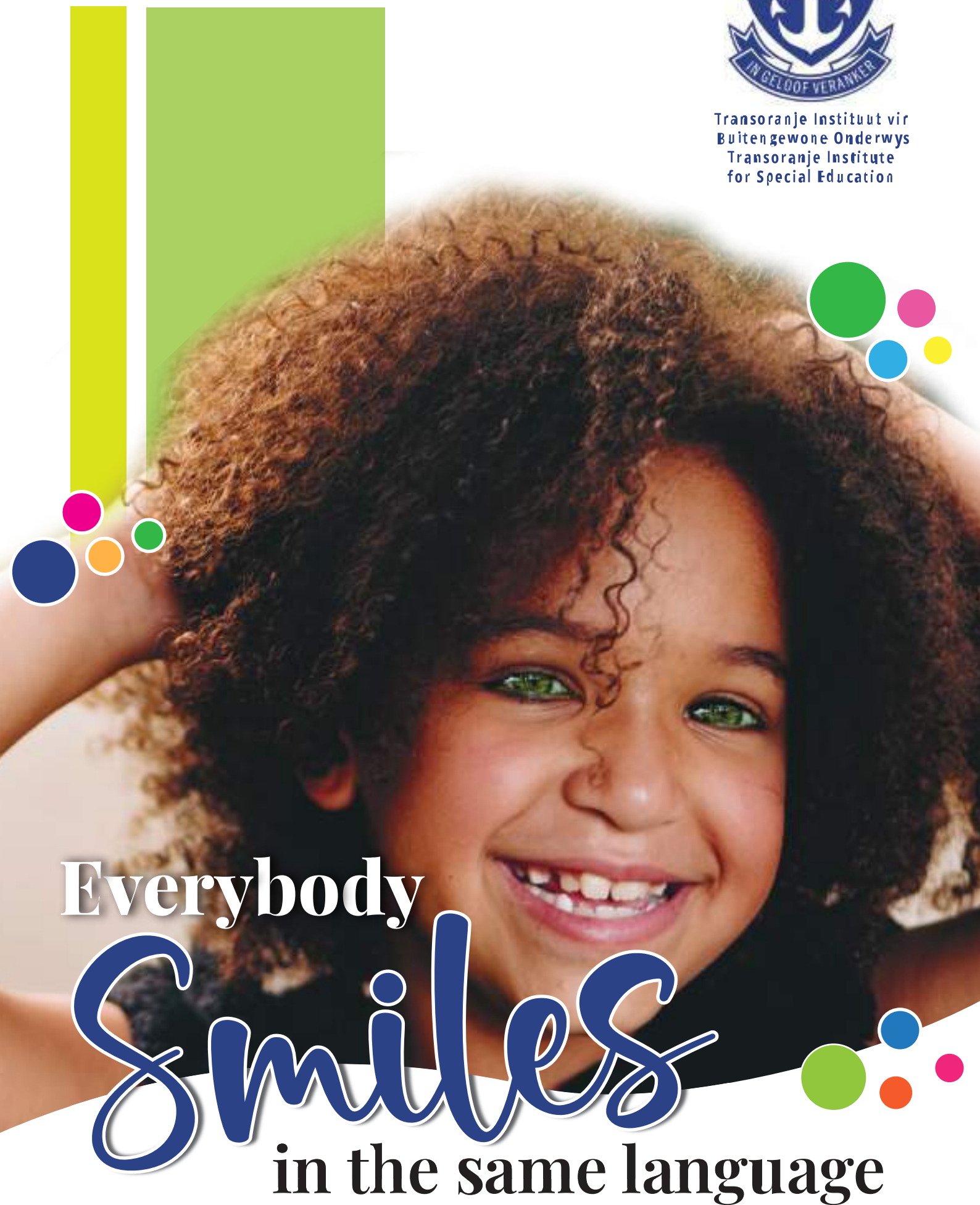

# Voorsitterse pen

Sedert 1961 is die Transoranje Instituut vir Buitengewone Onderwys (TOIBO) ten nouste verbonde aan haar vyf susterskole:

Transoranje-Skool, Martie du Plessis Skool, Transvalia-Skool, Prinshofskool en Sonitusskool. Twee van die TOIBO-skole behaal hierdie jaar besondere mylpale: Prinshofskool word 60 jaar oud, en Sonitusskool 50 jaar.

TOIBO se leuse is *In Geloof Veranker*. Geloof in die woorde van die Hebreër-skrywer is 'n vaste vertrouwe op die dinge wat ons hoop, 'n bewys van die dinge wat ons nie sien nie. TOIBO moes die afgelope jaar in hierdie geloof leef, omdat ons nie in die toekoms kon insien nie. Die Instituut het die toekoms met hoop ingegaan, omdat die Instituut die afgelope 76 jaar kon sien en beleef hoe die kerke, borge, donateurs, boedels, maatskappye en finansiële instellings deur hul bydraes bygedra het tot die instandhouding van die Instituut. In die antieke wêreld het die gelowiges teruggekyk om vorentoe te kyk omdat uit die verlede beleef is en gesien is hoe God voorsien het. Dit is met hierdie vertrouwe dat die Instituut leef.

In November/Desember 2022 het die matriekleerders van die vyf LSOB-skole verbonde aan TOIBO die matriekeindeksamen geskryf. Die Instituut wil die vyf Instituukskole gelukwens met hul pragtige matriekuitslae – en nie net die matriekuitslae nie, maar die akademiese prestasies van elke leerder in elke graad. The mission of TOIBO is to enable learners with special educational needs to reach their potential

by means of physical resources and support within a Christian ethos. During the past year the Institute was able to subsidise underprivileged learners with school fees, hostel fees, school clothes and shoes, food parcels and feeding schemes. The Christian ethos is expressed in the mottos of the schools: *hope; forwards in faith; towards the light; through faith; and conquerors*. If members of the public were to browse through the webpages of the different schools, they would be enlightened about the successes and achievements of our learners. Successes and achievements that we celebrate with the learners, their teachers, support staff, parents and/or guardians.



The Institute wishes to thank all involved in the schools: the principals and their management teams, the school governing bodies for governance, the teaching staff, therapists, psychologists, social workers, nurses, kitchen staff and house mothers.

A total of 100 matriculants took the exam and obtained a 99% pass rate. Only one learner will take the re-examination in June. The learners achieved 12 distinctions.

Congratulations to all the schools and all the learners on your beautiful achievements in 2022.

We need donations to manage the following projects and put a smile on the faces of our children with disabilities:

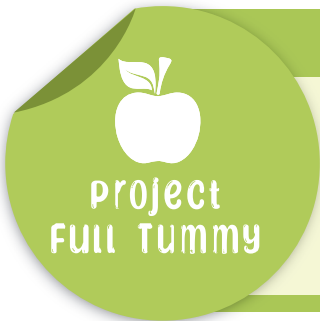


## Project Sunshine

This project assists underprivileged children at the different schools with, among others, hostel fees, transport costs, a feeding scheme, clothing, toiletries, stationery, and unforeseen expenses.

## Project Full Tummy

With this project we try to ensure that no child attends school or goes to bed on an empty stomach. Some learners receive meals at school, others receive packed lunches during breaks. Many learners receive grocery parcels to take home, especially during school holidays. Donations of cash or non-perishable food are appreciated.



## Project School Shoes

Many learners seldom receive new school shoes. We want to ensure that every underprivileged child has a fresh pair of school shoes that fits.



## Project Warm Body

Many of our children must endure public transport during cold winter mornings, and large cold classrooms. We want to ensure that every underprivileged child remains warm and healthy throughout the cold winter.



## Project Dignity

We try to avoid that the children are humiliated because of torn or too small school uniforms or other clothes, or because they must borrow other learners' stationery. Think of the embarrassment of girls who do not have the necessary sanitary ware to attend school, or any basic toiletries. With this project we try to collect enough products to assist the underprivileged learners. Donations of sanitary ware, stationery and clothing are always welcome.

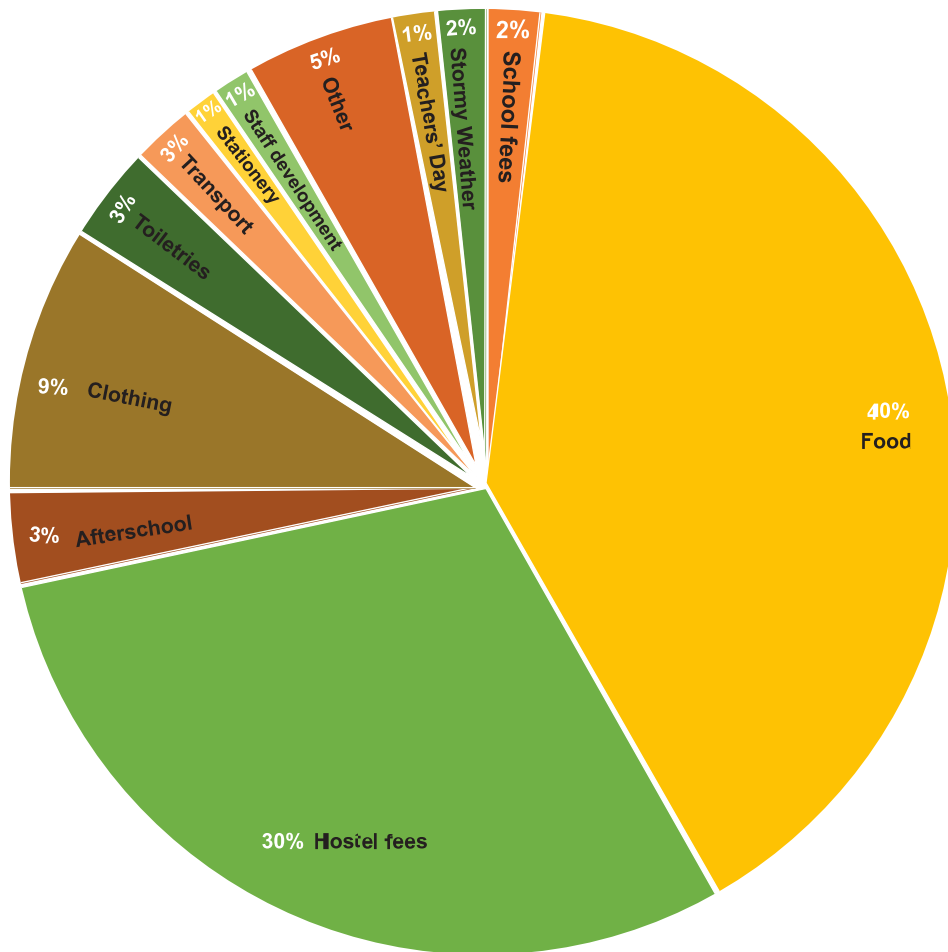


## Project Stormy Weather

# Stories of hope

## My story of hope... Jason Mc Mahon

My name is Jason Mc Mahon and I have been struggling with dyslexia all my life. But a very, very special school called High School Martie du Plessis changed all of that for me.



I always had a dream of working with aircraft, flying them and maintaining them. I graduated from High School Martie du Plessis in 2018, and thanks to all the support and confidence-building that the school provided on a daily basis, I decided to follow my dream. In 2020 I started with my studies at 43 Air School in Port Alfred to become an AME (Aircraft Maintenance Engineer).

I qualified as an aircraft technician on 5 August 2022. It was one of the biggest challenges I've ever had to face in my life, but using my disability as my biggest ability, got me through it. Currently, I work in Cape Town for a company called Robin Coss Aviation, where we build Van's RV Aircraft. The best thing about this industry is that you can be creative.

You encounter problems, and more importantly, you find solutions to those problems. Nothing can describe the feeling when you see an aircraft that you built, flying for the very first time. I have a lot of plans for my future, especially to start flying someday. **My success would never have been possible without all the incredible teachers and staff at Martie du Plessis.**



# Stories van hoop: Izak Rohan Crafford

Die blinde het twee oosies. Hy kan blindheid óf tot die primêre definiërende faktor van sy identiteit maak, hom van die samelewing afwend en homself as iets besonder ag, óf hy aanvaar sy blindheid maar verstaan dit bloot as 'n stuk werklikheid wat nie sy identiteit as mens en omgang met die samelewing bepaal nie, selfs al spruit verskeie uitdagings daaruit voort.

Laasgenoemde is nie die maklikste opsie nie, maar, aangemoedig deur die oopvoeding van my ouers en verskeie onderwysers, is dit die koers wat ek ingeslaan het. (Ek kan ook noem dat dit uit die perspektiewe van sowel siende as siggestremde persone die mensliker keuse is.)

Gevolglik het ek gedurende die Desembervakansie direk na my matriekeksamen met my toekomstige Latyn-tutor in verbinding getree en die eerste verkenning van die Hatfield-kampus van die Universiteit van Pretoria vir Januarie 2019 georganiseer – die begin van 'n uitdagende dog lieflike pelgrimstog om die wêreld te verken. Dit is immers ongelukkig so dat blindes dikwels vreeslik geïsoleerd leef en selde die geleentheid kry om goeie verhoudinge met nie-blindes op te bou.



Dit het ek veral besef nadat ek by 'n daghuis betrokke geraak het, waar ek, geïnspireer deur my eie uitstekende mentor, in my tweede en derde jaar ook as mentor gedien het. Sonder hierdie blootstelling aan siende mense en die opbou van stabiele vriendskapsverhoudinge, twyfel ek of my studies my sou kon lei tot waar ek nou gekom het.



Buitendien kan die liefde vir taal en literatuur slegs ontwikkel waar mensekennis en ervaring van menseverhoudinge bestaan. Dit is vir taalstudies dat ek ingeskryf het en ek het vroeg reeds besef dat dit die regte besluit was, selfs al wou ek op hoërskool plaatkunde studeer.

Die liefde vir taal wat ek van my ma ontvang het en tydens my skoolloopbaan by Prinshofskool kon slyp, het my aangespoor om sowel Duits as Latyn ywerig aan te leer. As gevolg van my ounie vir Duits in die eerste semester van my tweede jaar, het ek die uitnodiging ontvang om aan die literatuurbesprekings van die honneurs-leitendestudente deel te neem, wat my Duitse taalvaardigheid 'n goeie huustoot gegee het en my toegelaat het om my liefde vir die taal te ontdek. Ten spyte van die inperking en die uitdagings wat daarmee geopaardgegaan het, het ek my voorgraadse studies in 2021 met onderskeiding afgesluit, met Engels en Duits as hoofvakke.



Maar dit is veral die Duitse taal en sy ryk skat van letterkunde en kultuur wat my aangetrek het, en ek het besluit om my honneursgraad in Duits te doen, wat ek aan die einde van verlede jaar, ook met onderskeiding, kon afsluit. As die Here wil, sal ek hierdie jaar my meestersgraad in Duits aanpak.

Bowendien het ek in November 2021 'n aanbod gekry om as assistentdosent van Duitse letterkunde op te tree, soesifiek vir die literatuurgeskiedenis kursus wat in die derde jaar van die Departement Antieke Taal en Kultuur se Duits-program aangebied word.



Die doel sou wees om praktiese ervaring op te bou om die didaktiekursus wat ek verlede jaar gevolg het, aan te vul. Hierdie aanbod is aan die einde van verlede jaar weer gemaak, nadat ek 'n suksesvolle eerste doseerjaar agter die rug gehad het, en ek het dit met 'n blye hart aangeneem, veral omdat ek sedert ek klein was seker was dat ek in die onderwys sou beland.

Daar is min dinge wat soveel vreugde bring soos 'n groeie studente wat ywerig aan 'n bespreking van *Die Bürgschaft* van Schiller of 'n ander groot werk uit die Duitse letterkundegeskiedenis deelneem. Daarbenewens dien ek sedert 2021 as orrelis by die St Wilfrid's Anglikaanse kerk en het ek my by

die studentebediening laat betrek. Sonder die Christelike grondslag sou ek nie kon onderrig soos ek dit graag wil doen en soos die studente wat aan my toevertrou word, verdien nie. Uitdagings kom dikwels voor, maar daar is altyd iemand tuis, aan die universiteit of by die kerk, wat bereid is om 'n helpende hand uit te strek.

Die blinde wie se wese deur sy blindheid bepaal word, bly eensaam en verstote op die verhoog agter, soos die hertog aan die einde van Friedrich Dürrenmatt se stuk *Der Blinde*. Sou ek wou hê dat 'n les uit bostaande ontstaan, is dit in die vorige sin saamgevat.

Dr Wynand de Wet, Pretoria-born, completed his school career at Hoërskool Oos-Moot, and obtained BA, BA (Hons) (Psychology), IIED, MEd (Psych), and PhD at the University of Pretoria. Early in his career he became involved with Transoranje School for the Deaf, completing his internship in Educational Psychology there in 1987. He got married to Karin, a teacher at Transoranje.

Their two children, Carine and Jaco, were also closely involved with Transoranje. After compulsory military service, he rejoined Transoranje in 1990, first as an educational psychologist, then intern psychologist, and thereafter full-time psychologist. He was deputy principal from 1998, teaching several subjects. Apart from his school obligations, he formed an essential part of the then annual Christmas Market Committee, and he ensured that the school made progress technologically.

He was the acting principal from July 2015, and in December 2015 he was appointed as the new principal. During his six and a half years as principal, he led the school with great success through trying times. Due to poor health, Dr De Wet decided to retire at the end of July 2022.

# Totsiens

## MNR JOHAN STAPELBERG ► HOOF SONITUSSKOOL

Johan Stapelberg is 'n Pretorianer in murg en been, en 'n onderwysmens. Sy loopbaan in die onderwys het 'n paar draaie geneem, maar die deurlopende jare wat hy by 'n skool was, toon sy lojaliteit en diensbaarheid aan die onderwys. Sy eerste benoeming in die onderwys was by Hoërskool Menlopark in Januarie 1979, waar hy begin het as opvoeder vir Afrikaans en later, in 1985, bevorder is tot departementshoof van Opvoedkundige Leiding.

Daarna word hy in April 1991 bevorder tot adjunkhoof by Hoërskool Waterkloof, waar hy ook betrokke was by groot ontwikkelinge. In 1993 is hy bevorder tot senior adjunkhoof by Nuwe Hoop Skool. Daar raak hy betrokke by talle komitees, besture, taakspanne, en rade ter bevordering van LSOB-onderwys. Hy kon in verskeie sportkodes, vir leerders met gestremdhede, atlete tot wennerspodiums lei, en het gedien as voorsitter van die destydse Noord-Transvaalse Vereniging vir Gestremdes, en later van SPDGN (Services to Persons with Disability Gauteng North). In dié tyd word hy as lid van 'n taakspan gestuur na die ISEC (Inclusive and Supportive Education Congress) aan die Universiteit van Strathclyde in Glasgow, Skotland. In Januarie 2010 word hy gesekondeer na Sonitus as waarnemende hoof, en in Oktober 2010 is hy aangestel as hoof. Hy het steeds betrokke gebly by LSOB-aangeleenthede en het bygedra tot beter subsidiebedelings vir LSOB-skole in Gauteng, wat later ook landwyd 'n impak gehad het.



Hy was ook 'n dryfkrag agter die vestiging van 'n meer omvattende driebaanmodel vir onderwys in Suid-Afrika (CAPS, SID, TOC).

Onder sy leiding is Sonitus vir opeenvolgende jare as Atletiek Skolekampioene aangewys. Hy was betrokke by die Blou Bulle Rugby vir Buitengewone Onderwys (BBRBO) Gauteng-Noord, waar hy ook as voorsitter van dié vereniging gedien het. Hy het gedien as voorsitter van die SAOU se LSOB-belangegroep en lid van die PUR (Provinsiale Uitvoerende Raad) van die SAOU, asook die PUR van FEDSAS vir LSOB-belange.

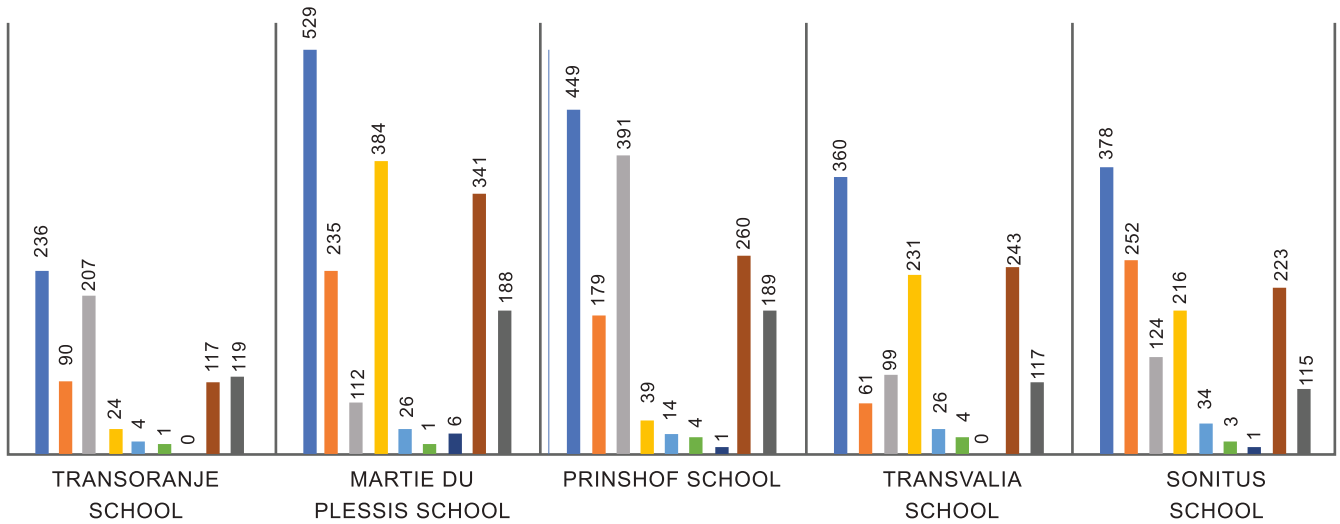

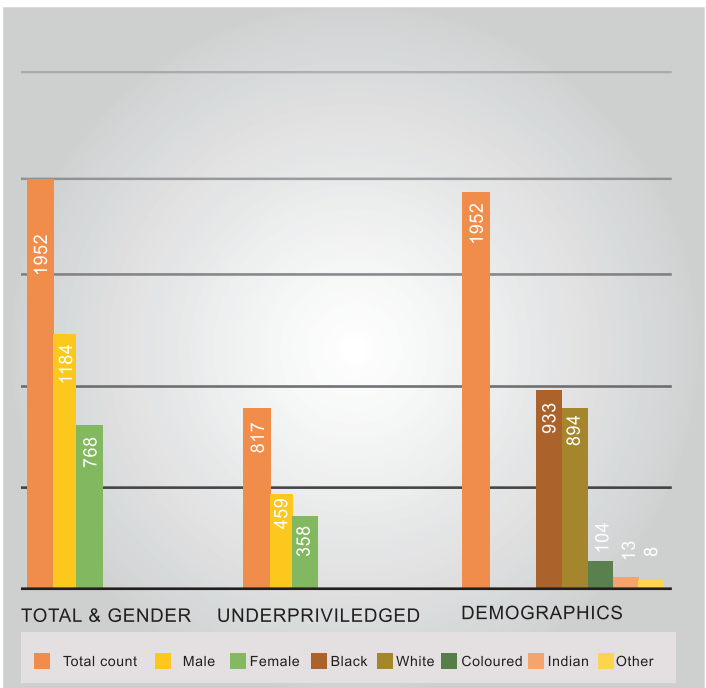

# Sonitus

## Skool vir Hardhorendes

The Sonitus blank canvas for 2022 awaited completion with the lines, strokes and colours to be added by educators, learners and parents. They would fill our year with wondrous moments, completing our masterpiece for 2022.

### BESTUUR

Na 12 jaar by Sonitus, kom 'n hoofstuk vir mnr Stapelberg tot 'n einde en moet ons vaarwel sê. Hy het 44 jaar aan onderwys toegewy, 30 jaar daarvan in gespesialiseerde onderwys. Ons wens hom sterkte en voorspoed toe vir die nuwe hoofstuk in sy lewe.

Die adjunkhoofde, mev Ada Steyn en mej Adele Kemp, sal afwisselend die leierskap van die skool behartig totdat 'n nuwe hoof aangestel is.

### NEW DIVISION

Sonitus started four new classes for learners from Via Nova, who will now be following the DCAPS (Differentiated Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statement) program at Sonitus. The learners contributed to the increase in learner numbers, which is beneficial for Sonitus's staff provision. The addition did however lead to other challenges, such as an increase in financial and feeding support.

### SPORT

Met die Covid-situasie wat verbeter het, kon Sonitus weer deelneem aan die jaarlikse Interskole Atletiekbyeenkoms en is Sonitus weer eens as wenerskool aangewys. Vir Sonitus is massadeelname belangrik en dus oefen die atlete soggens om te verseker dat leerders wat vervoerprobleme mag ondervind, ook kan deelneem.

Getalle vir rugby het afgeneem en daarom vorm ons rugbyspelers deel van kombinasiespanne met Transvalia-Skool en Nuwe Hoop Skool. Hierdie samewerking smee ook bande met personeel en leerders van ander gespesialiseerde skole. Gedurende die tweede kwartaal het die dogters netbal gespeel, en Sonitusskool het 'n netbaldag gehou waaraan omliggende LSOB-skole deelgeneem het.

Sagtebalspanne vir seuns het goed gevaar in die hoofstroomliga en het tot die halfeindstryd deurgedring.



## FONDSINSAMELING EN DIE KERSPROJEK

Sonitusskool kry maandeliks die geleentheid om by die Pretoria Oumotorklub fondse in te samel deur middel van die hektoegang, wat deur ons leerlingraad behartig word en toegeken word aan ons behoeftige-leerders-fonds. Daar is ook geleentheid vir die koshuispersoneel om verkope te doen, van pannekoek, worsbroodjies en koffie. Hierdie verkope se fondse word benut om vir elke koshuiskind 'n Kersgeskenkie te koop en hul jaareindafsluiting 'n heerlike bederf te maak. Met 'n addisionele bydrae van 'n anonieme borg, kon elke kind se geskenklysie van drie items aan Kersvader ten minste met twee verwesenlik word.

Blink geskenke, Kersliggies, 'n Kersboom en Kersliedere is vir baie van ons leerders nie deel van hul verwysingsraamwerk nie. Jaarliks bied mev Steyn 'n Kerssangdiens aan waartydens die leerders met 'n klein geskenkie, geborg deur die personeel en 'n anonieme donateur, bederf word.

## KULTUUR

Die leerders se prestasies op kultuurvlak was ook weer uitstekend. Ons leerders wat aan voordrag deelgeneem het, het puik uitslae behaal en verskeie medaljes ontvang. Leerders wat in die kunsafdeling deelgeneem het, se kunswerke was van hoë gehalte en het goed

gevaar, met verskeie medaljes wat ontvang is. Tydens die jaarlikse aanbidding van Mnr en Mej Sonitus het die leerders gesprinkel op die loopplank en die personeel baie trots gemaak.

## CHALLENGES

We had various serious burglaries where, among other thefts, the school's palisades and electric fences were stolen. To combat burglaries, various security measures were taken. We are grateful to TOIBO for assisting us with the installation of three cameras at the sports fields. The governing bodies of Sonitus School and Transvalia School arranged for the construction of a wall between the schools and the adjacent suburb. The Gauteng Department of Education also erected a wall between Sonitus School, the river and TOIBO's reserve land, which helps a lot to prevent break-ins.

## PROJEK LEERKRAG

### ACADEMICS

Our learners perform well academically. The three phases we follow – CAPS, TOC (Technical Occupational Curriculum) and SID (Severe Intellectual Disability) – offer every learner a unique opportunity to progress at his or her own pace.

Our Grade 12 group of 2022 that wrote the National Senior Certificate Examination performed brilliantly. The class consisted of seven Afrikaans and five English learners. Sonitus is proud to announce that the class of 2022 achieved a 100% pass rate. One young man obtained two distinctions. We see this accomplishment as a group effort, because many of the learners have been with Sonitus since the Foundation Phase. That is why we are grateful for every person who, in whatever way, contributed to these wonderful results.

### FINANCES

The financial position of Sonitus School remains a challenge. The Gauteng Department of Education offers funding for the classes' technology, but municipal accounts and other obligatory expenses, such as textbooks, teachers' salaries, photocopies, stationery and the internet, remain high. Our aim for 2023 is to provide as much additional technological support to the teachers as possible, to enhance the educational experience of the learners. We remain grateful to TOIBO as owner of the land and the buildings, for their continued support, especially with the care of our underprivileged learners by means of Project Sunshine.

Sonitus stap 'n blink 2023 in, met die viering van ons 50ste bestaansjaar. Al het die profiel van Sonitus se leerders oor die jare verander, bedien ons steeds 'n gemeenskap van

## School for the Visually Impaired

Die skoolgemeenskap het 2022 met nuutgevonde entoesiasme aangepak. Prinshofskool streef daarna om hul visie en missie van uitsonderlike gespesialiseerde onderwys aan visueel gestremde leerders te bied.

### ATLETIEK

Aan die begin van die jaar het 'n groot aantal leerders aan die Interhuis-atletiekbyeenkoms deelgeneem. Dit was 'n wonderlike ervaring om weer vry te kon deelneem, sonder maskers, hoewel ons steeds 'n sosiale afstand in gedagte gehou het. Tydens die Prestigebyeenkoms in Boksburg was daar heelwat uitblinkers wat verskeie goue, silwer en brons medaljes verower het.

### WACKY WEDNESDAYS

The process of returning to normality inspired creative new ideas for extramural activities. Learners had the opportunity to participate in blind cricket, soccer, swimming, netball, martial arts, and gymnasium activities. Cultural activities included chess, public speaking, library activities, ICT development, eisteddfod, a chamber choir, and a boys' choir. This year we will be introducing judo for Grade 1 to Grade 3 learners.



### AKADEMIESE FOKUS

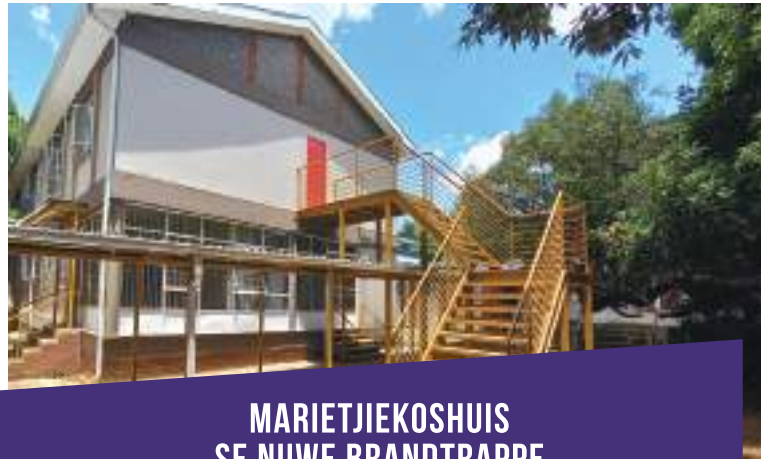
Die personeel het besonder hard gewerk en elke geleentheid benut om die akademie te verbeter. Die onderwysers bied drie middae per week ekstra klasse aan om optimale akademiese resultate te verseker.

Beroepsvoorligting was een van die skool se hoofdoelwitte, sodat ouers en leerders bygestaan kon word om ingeligte besluite ten opsigte van loopbaangerigte vakkeuses te maak. Die leerders is deurlopend met inskrywings by verskeie tersiêre inrigtings ondersteun. Prinshofskool bied drie verskillende kurrikulums aan.

### KLAS VAN 2022

## SUPPORT

The number of underprivileged learners increases annually. The school tries to help these underprivileged learners with transport cost and food parcels during holidays. The school also has a daily feeding scheme, and a clothing bank is available.

## INFRASTRUCTURE

The school governing body played a huge role in enhancing the school's infrastructure. Emergency staircases were built at three hostels. New shelters were erected at the sports field, with seating for learners. The continuous maintenance creates a beautiful and safe school environment. A new generator that can provide electricity to the whole school, was procured with the help of a sponsor. This has an extremely positive effect on our curriculum delivery.

## ENTRANCE

We are thrilled that, after nine years, the City of Tshwane approved the application for the school's entrance to be moved to Soutpansberg Road. The Gauteng Department of Education and stakeholders are now planning to build a new gate.

## School for the Deaf

Dit is vir my 'n voorreg om verslag te doen oor Transoranje-Skool se wel en wee van die afgelope jaar. Mrs Fourie contributed extensively to Transoranje's history. Many of our Deaf adult class assistants started their school careers in Mrs Fourie's class in the Foundation Phase. She was well loved by staff and learners at the school and moulded many little minds with love and understanding. She accompanied our learners overseas with their Sign Language choir performances and was one of the key role players of the Transoranje Christmas Market. We learned from Amanda that nothing is unachievable. During her time at Transoranje School she often fulfilled the role of acting principal.

## ACADEMICS

We are very proud of our four Grade 12 learners who passed the endorsed matric exam in 2022. The proverb *it takes a village to raise a child* comes to mind. Although it was the Further Education and Training (FET) teachers who ran the last lap with these four, with extra classes during weekends and holidays, I want to honour every staff member from the pre-school phase to the hostel who played a part in supporting these learners to reach their goal.

In 2023 we again have four learners aiming for gold. This will be the last group with Afrikaans as a subject. From 2024 Afrikaans will be phased out as first additional subject at the school and will be replaced with English.

## ◀◀ TRANSORANJE-SKOOL VERVOLG

We are thrilled that we could admit many new learners during the first ten days. To meet every learner's specific and individual needs, we follow three different curriculums:

- The CAPS (Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statement) for Grades R to 12, for the learners who can conform to the academic requirements.
- The TOC (Technical Occupational Curriculum) four-year program for learners who are practically inclined.
- The DCAPS (Differentiated Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statement) is followed by learners who experience serious academic challenges.

## SPORT

After two years of nearly no sport due to Covid, Transoranje School took to the sports fields with enthusiasm. The school decided to follow a different approach with sport. We decided on an approach of *everybody's participating*. During sports periods all the learners had the opportunity to choose a sports code they wanted to participate in. All the learners were doing some sort of sport twice a week. Table tennis, gymnastics and cross-country were also introduced as new sports codes.

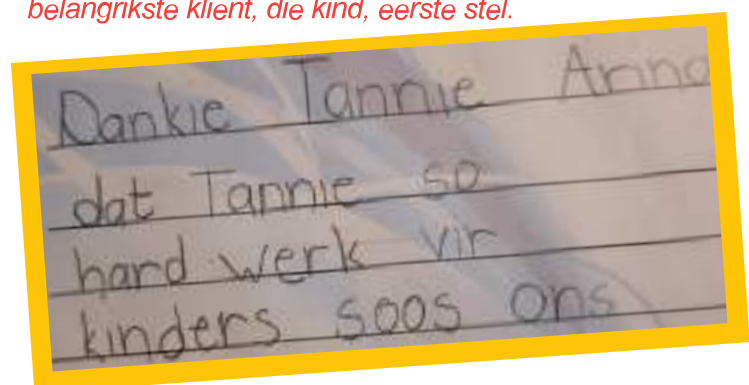
