Uit die Voorsitter se pen

Die wyse Prediker van die Bybel het by geleentheid opgemerk:
*Wat was, sal weer wees; wat gebeur het, sal weer gebeur.
Daar is niks nuuts in hierdie wêreld nie (Pred 1:9).*

'n Mens wil soms ook iets van hierdie waarheid in 'n jaarverslag se voorsittersboodskap inlees – 'n opsomming van wat was en 'n blik op wat nog moet kom. Alles in ag genome, is daar werklik iets nuuts?

Tog is 'n jaarverslag veel meer as 'n weergawe van enkele hoogte- en laagtepunte van 'n gegewe jaar. Ten diepste is 'n jaarverslag 'n getuienis van ons Here se werk – in hierdie geval hoe Hy in en deur TOIBO en ons vyf Instituut-skole gewerk het. TOIBO was en is immers geanker in ons leuse en belydenis: In geloof veranker. Dit is wie TOIBO is en wie TOIBO altyd wil bly.

Die voorsitter se taak is die makliker deel van diens – jy tree op as koördineerder. Die mense wat al die kosbare werk op grondvlak verrig het, is ons uitvoerende beampte, mev Alta Koekemoer, saam met die res van die Dagbestuur, en dan in die besonder ook die skoolhoofde en personeel van die skole self.

Tog kon en kan TOIBO en die vyf Instituut-skole nie onafhanklik op hul eie funksioneer nie. Ons Here voorsien al 79 jaar lank getrou. Hy voorsien deur kerke, besighede, trusts, welwillendheidsorganisasies, individue en op so baie ander besondere maniere. Hier by TOIBO word skenkings nooit as vanselfsprekend aanvaar nie. Ons hartlike dank aan elkeen wat bygedra het gedurende die afgelope jaar en in vorige jare.

2025 het sy eie unieke uitdagings gehad. Die druk op veral ons LSOB-skole is enorm. Onderwys word net duurder en duurder. Die getal ouers wat nie in staat is om skoolgelde te betaal nie, neem geweldig toe. Ongelukkig leef ons ook met die werklikheid dat skole nie meer genoegsame befondsing en ondersteuning van die Departement van Onderwys kry nie, terwyl die druk om te presteer ook elke jaar toeneem. 'n Hartseer werklikheid is die toenemende getal behoeftige leerders wat by ons skole voeding ontvang – dikwels hul enigste kos vir die dag! Hulpverlening aan skole om hierdie leerders te kan voed, is 'n besondere deel van TOIBO se roeping.

Daar was egter ook 'n ander werklikheid, naamlik dié van groot genade en prestasies ten spyte van baie uitdagings. By Transvalia-Skool is, met ingang van 2026, 'n nuwe hoof, dr Adriaan Ackerman, aangestel. Baie geluk aan hom. In van ons ander skole is sleutelposte ook gevul. Ons is dankbaar oor hierdie aanstellings.

Soos in die skoolhoofde se verslae uiteengesit, is ons ook dankbaar oor die matriekuitslae. Daar was benewens die akademie ook mooi sport- en kultuurprestasies. Om 'n enkele skool se prestasie uit te sonder is gewaagd, maar dit verdien vermeld te word dat Prinshofskool in Januarie aangewys is as die *Best Performing LSEN School in Gauteng* vir 2025. Voorwaar 'n besondere prestasie!

Elkeen van ons skole is in eie reg 'n toppresterder. So ook ons skoolhoofde en personeel. Hulle is die mense wat ons kinders se potensiaal ontsluit. Elke leerder is in sy of haar uniekheid 'n baanbreker.

Laastens herinner ons graag dat TOIBO besig is om gereed te maak vir ons 80ste bestaansjaarvieringe in 2027.

Uiteindelik kan ons maar net klein word voor ons Here se genade.

Ek kyk terug na 2025 met opregte dankbaarheid en staan in verwondering oor hoe duidelik ons Vader se hand in TOIBO se doen en late te sien was. Ons jaartema, *Breaking Barriers*, het nie net aan ons werk rigting gegee nie, maar ook aan ons ingesteldheid. Saam met ons donateurs, kerke en vennote kon ons werklik struikelblokke uit die weg help ruim vir leerders wat elke dag besondere uitdagings beleef. Met groot opgewondenheid kyk ek vooruit na 2026 en ons nuwe tema, *TOIBO unlocks potential*. Hierdie tema bou natuurlik voort op *Breaking Barriers* – want wanneer hindernisse verwyder word, kan potensiaal begin blom!

Potential is unlocked when support meets opportunity.

Danksy getroue ondersteuning kon ons al ons finansiële verpligtinge nakom en R1 000 380 in kontant aan die skole voorsien, tesame met talle produkskenkings. Daarmee kon ons die skole help om 855 behoeftige kinders te ondersteun. Hierdie getal neem steeds jaarliks toe. Alle donasies word doelgerig aangewend vir onder meer skool- en koshuisfoeie, vervoerkoste, skryfbehoeftes, klerasie, sanitêre produkte en voeding. Bykans 500 leerders ontvang daaglik etes by die onderskeie skole – noodsaaklike ondersteuning wat leervermoë, konsentrasie en welstand direk beïnvloed.

Die kerke het in 2025 op 'n besondere wyse saamgewerk – nie net met finansiële bydraes nie, maar ook met tasbare produkskenkings wat 'n daadwerklike verskil aan die leerders se daaglikse lewens maak. Skryfbehoeftes, higiëneprodukte en warm klere het vir baie kinders meer as net hulp beteken – dit het hul waardigheid herstel. Ons is opreg dankbaar vir gemeentes wat TOIBO se projekte ondersteun, ons ruimte gee vir bewusmaking, en help om ons storie verder uit te dra.



Throughout the year, the schools continued to face significant pressure, financially, administratively and emotionally. Subsidy issues, staffing challenges and growing academic expectations put strain on both educators and learners. TOIBO's role has been to support the schools with consistency and compassion. Through financial support, moral encouragement and donor engagement, we made certain that the schools did not have to face these challenges on their own.

It has been encouraging to see how the schools continue to strengthen their teaching and learning by introducing new subject fields and creating new opportunities for the learners. Some of the schools upgraded their facilities and expanded during 2025. This is a testimony of their pride, commitment and long-term investment to serve the learners who have special educational needs. We also focused on strengthening the connection between our donors and the schools. Due to more exposure and engagement throughout the year, donors were enabled to better understand the realities, needs and potential of LSEN education and TOIBO's involvement. We believe that this will lead to long-term partnerships with our supporters.

Soos elke gemeenskap, het ons skole ook lief en leed beleef. Ons harte gaan uit na Sonitusskool en Prinshofskool wat personeelsterftes ervaar het. Ons is bly saam met die skole waar langverwagte bestuursposte uiteindelik gevul is en stabiliteit kon herstel. Transvalia-Skool kon vanjaar ook begin met 'n nuwe hoof, dr Adriaan Ackerman, wat deel geword het van die TOIBO-familie. Daarby het talle leerders en personeellede besondere prestasies provinsiaal, nasionaal en internasionaal behaal en ons vervul met trots.

Ons spog ook graag met die pragtige graad 12-uitslae. Ten spyte van 'n groot diversiteit van gestremdhede en toenemende leerprobleme, het die skole oor die algemeen 'n verbetering in akademiese prestasies ervaar. 120 matrikulante het die Nasionale Senior Sertifikaat-eksamen in 2025 geskryf, en puik prestasies is behaal. Prinshofskool, Transoranje Skool en Sonitusskool spog elk met 'n 100%-slaagsyfer, terwyl Martie du Plessis kort op hul hakke is met 98% en Transvalia-Skool met 88,5%. Gesamentlik is 43 onderskeidings behaal. Lees gerus elders in hierdie verslag meer oor die skole.

As we move into 2026, our theme of unlocking potential invites us to look beyond the immediate needs and to invest in sustainable growth regarding our learners, schools and partnerships. On behalf of TOIBO, I extend my sincere thanks to every donor, church and business that walked this journey with us. We also want to thank every staff member of the five schools for all your love and care, and for teaching our special children. Your involvement brings hope, restores dignity and opens doors to brighter futures.

Together, let us continue to unlock potential – one learner, one school and one partnership at a time.

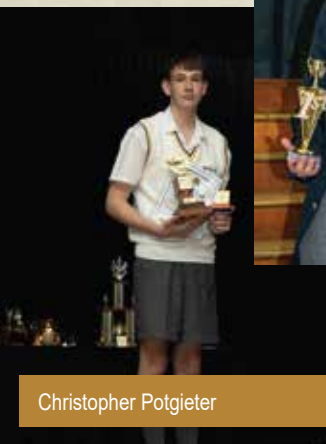
MARTIE DU PLESSIS

High School Martie du Plessis is proud of the 98% pass rate achieved by the 52 matriculants of 2025. 65% passed with a bachelor's pass, 25% with a diploma pass, and 8% with an endorsed pass. Overall they obtained 12 distinctions.

Storie van Hoop

Hoe Martie du Plessis my lewe verander het

Ek het in 2003 my graad 12 aan Hoërskool Martie du Plessis voltooi en daar gematrikuleer. Wanneer ek vandag terugdink aan daardie jare, besef ek dat dit veel meer was as bloot 'n tydperk van akademiese groei. Dit was 'n vormingsfase – een wat my waardes, my manier van dink en uiteindelik my loopbaanpad diep beïnvloed het.

Martie du Plessis was nie net 'n skool nie, dit was 'n gemeenskap waar elke leerder se unieke vermoëns en uitdagings raakgesien en waardeer is. Ek het daar geleer dat onderwys nie net gaan oor punte en prestasie nie, maar oor mense. Dit gaan oor begrip, deernis en respek vir elke individu, ongeag hul vermoë of beperking.

Wat my die meeste bybly, is die toewyding van die onderwysers. Ek het met bewondering gekyk hoe hulle, met eindelose geduld en liefde, met leerders met spesiale behoeftes werk. Hulle het elke kind laat voel asof hy of sy behoort – asof daar 'n plek is waar hulle veilig kan voel en waardeer word. Dit het iets in my binneste aangeraak, 'n roeping om self eendag so 'n verskil te kan maak.

Vandag is ek bevoorreg om deel te wees van die span by **Carel du Toit Spesiale Skool in Bloemfontein**, 'n skool vir leerders met gehoorgestremdhede. Elke dag herinner my daaraan hoe diep hierdie roeping in my geplant is. Ek sien hoe kinders met spesiale behoeftes groei wanneer hulle liefde en aanmoediging ontvang en met begrip hanteer word.

As ek terugkyk, weet ek sonder twyfel dat Martie du Plessis Skool my nie net vir 'n beroep voorberei het nie, maar vir 'n lewe van betekenis. Dit het my nie net kennis gegee nie, maar 'n hart vir diens en geloof dat elke kind, ongeag sy of haar vermoë, die potensiaal het om te skitter.

Martie du Plessis het nie net my pad gevorm nie – dit het my my lewensroeping help ontdek.

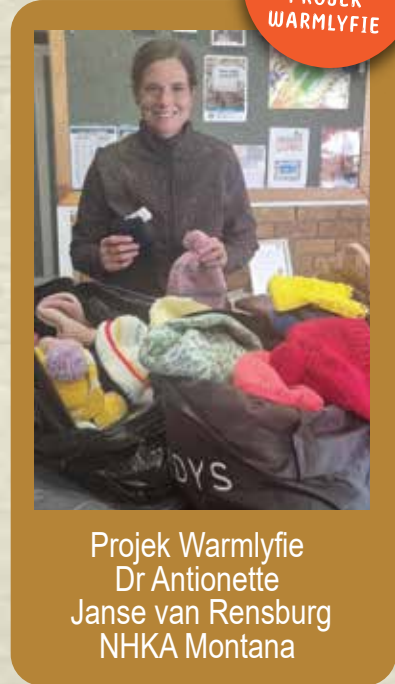

In primary school, I also loved to participate in ice-skating competitions, and I used to sing in duets. I also did poetry and sighted reading.

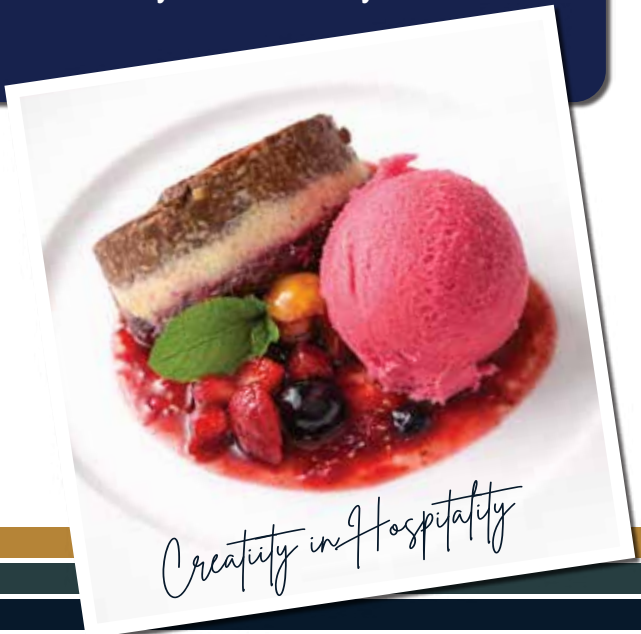
In Grade 10, I joined the Senior Council and eventually became vice-president in Grade 12.

In 2013, I commenced work at the National Council of and for Persons with Disabilities (NCPD). That is where I discovered my greatest inspiration. I started with elementary filing, but gradually acquired financial skills. Through hard work and perseverance I was promoted often, and today I proudly serve as National Office Manager.

Many learners seldom receive new school shoes.

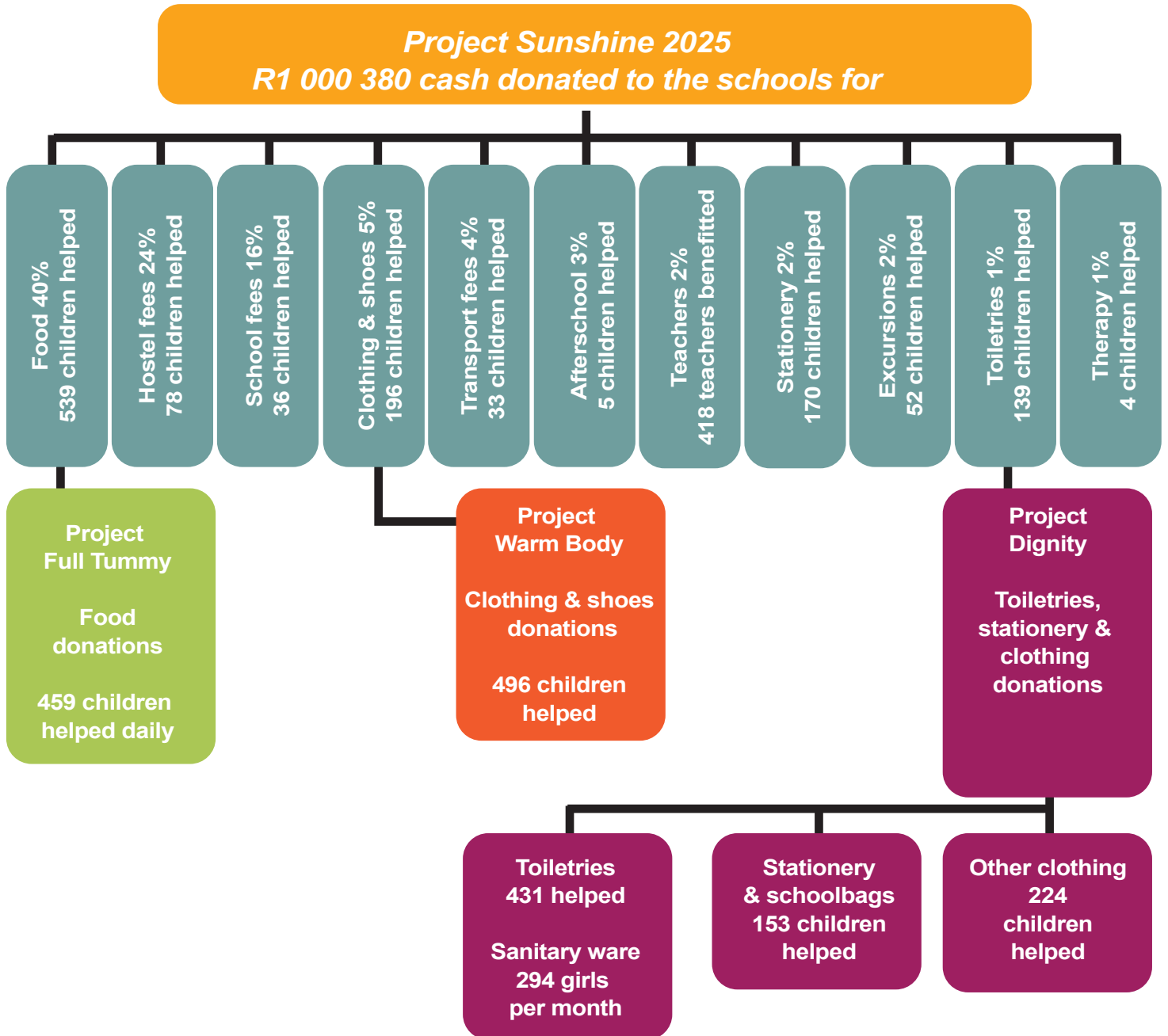
We want to ensure that every underprivileged child has a fresh pair of school shoes that fits.

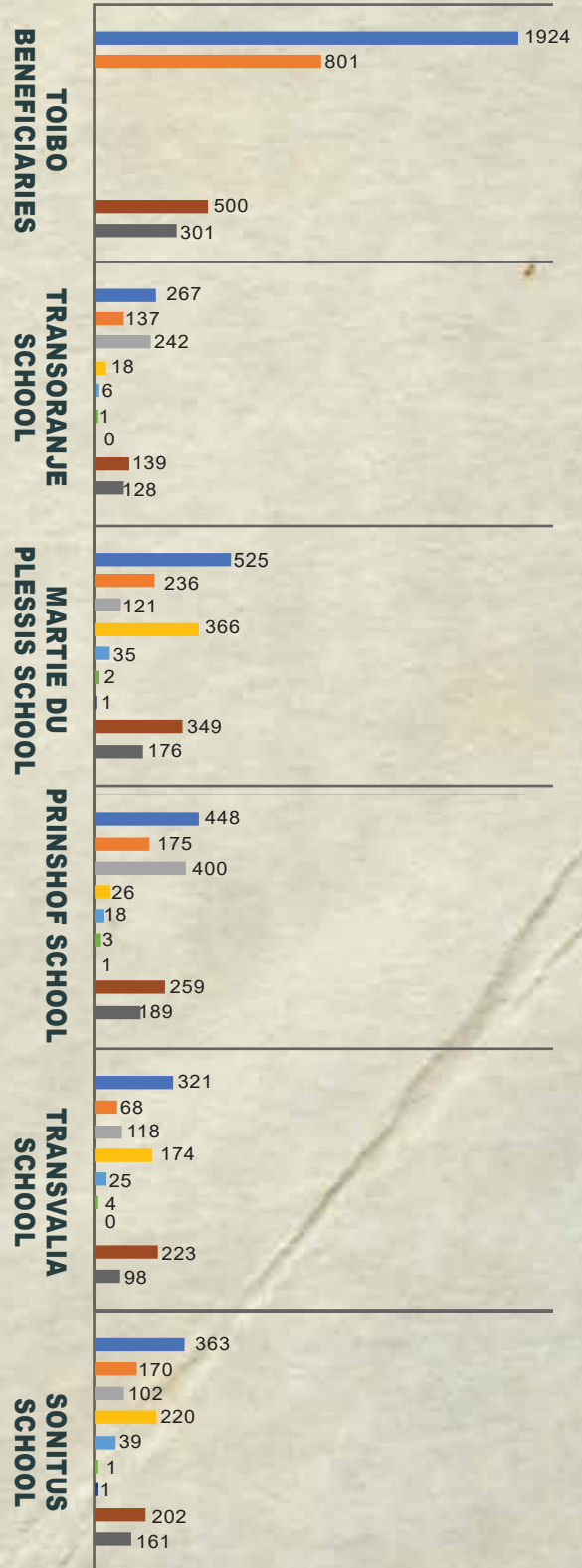

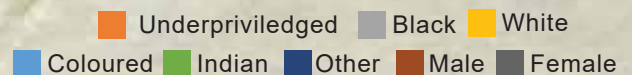

Mev Nolène Rademan is op 30 September verkies as streeksverteenvoerder van die SAOU se Provinsiale Uitvoerende Raad.



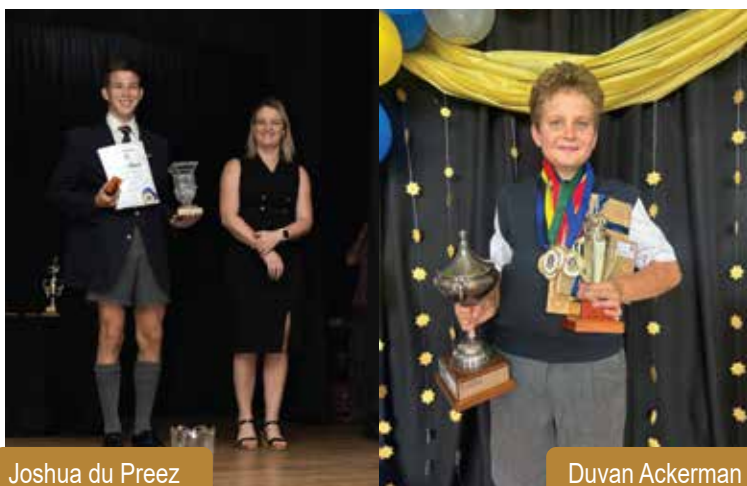
Mrs Reinette Myburgh served as a provincial moderator for Grade 12 Life Orientation after serving for two years as a district moderator.

HELPING HANDS TO MAKE THE FUTURE BRIGHTER



In June 2025, 17 staff members – teachers and therapists – attended the District Base Accommodation Committee's (DBAC's) training to be a reader, scribe, prompter or personal assistant. This enables us to continue delivering the best possible service when catering for our learners. As a team, we strive for excellence.



PARENTAL GUIDANCE AT TRANSVALIA

Through close collaboration between our social worker and our disciplinary head, our parental guidance platform continues to improve. Interventions range from individual parental support to parental information sessions and home-school collaboration where parents are encouraged to engage with teachers regarding their children's academic and behavioural progress. This partnership between the social worker and the disciplinary head creates a more supportive and consistent approach to learner development. Our social worker's involvement is also crucial in identifying families in need.

VOEDINGSKEMA EN OMGEEPROJEK

Gedurende 2025 was daar 'n toename in die getal gesinne wat kospakkies benodig en leerders wat daaglikse broodjies ontvang. Daar is tans 45 leerders wat daaglikse 'n broodjie kry. Sonitus se oorspronklike doelwit was om onderrig te bied aan Afrikaanse gehoorgestremde leerders, en ons het steeds 'n groot meerderheid Afrikaanse leerders wat in hul huistaal onderrig benodig.

Ons tweede aanbiedingstaal is Engels, en daar is toenemend leerders wat veral ons Tegniiese Beroepsfase betree en onderrig in Engels ontvang. In dié fase bied ons die twee tale gelyktydig aan in 'n klas van seuns en dogters, so ingedeel vir praktiese doeleindes. Sentrums en personeel is beperk en daarom is daar nie 'n groot verskeidenheid vakke wat aangebied kan word nie.

Die kultuur rondom leer en presteer het verander – leerders moet sterker gemotiveer word, en ouerondersteuning is ongelukkig min. Die Departement het in 2025 die kollig op ons laat val ten opsigte van akademiese prestasie, en gefokus op ons graad 6-leerders.

Die skoolhoof het aan senior departementele beamptes verduidelik dat Sonitus 'n skool is vir leerders met gespesialiseerde onderwysbehoefes, en dat ons aanbieding uniek is. Verskillende spesiale skole funksioneer nie dieselfde nie.

Sonitus volg drie kurrikulums, wat addisionele verpligtinge en verantwoordelikhede plaas op personeel wat soms in meer as een baan onderrig gee. Leerders in die verskillende bane, van graad R tot graad 12, het verskillende gestremdhede, en daar word van die personeel verwag om voldoende voorbereid te wees om die uitdagings te hanteer.

In die akademiese baan neem ons leerders Gasvryheidstudies. Aan die einde van die jaar bied elke groep 'n ete aan vir ouers en personeel – graad 10 sit 'n ontbyt voor, die graad 11-groep 'n *High Tea*, en die graad 12's se finale praktiese eksamen is 'n vyfgangmaaltyd. Dit is heerlike bederfoggende vir personeel en genooides.



Die leerders in die verstandelik erg gestremde afdeling bied twee maal 'n jaar 'n tegeleentheid met pragtige versierings en heerlike kos aan vir die Skoolbestuurspan. Hierdie geleentheid is een van die hoogtepunte in die leerders se jaarprogram.

Die TBF-dogters (Tegniese Beroepsfase) van Jaar 2 het hierdie jaar se naelkennis en masserings gaan toepas op inwoners van die Beth-Rapha-sentrum vir bejaardes, waar 'n inwoner van 104 jaar oud vir die dogters en Sonitus gebid het... watter spesiale geleentheid! Die Jaar 3-dogters het die terapeute van die Angel Spa and Beauty Studio in Sinoville gaan bederf met hand-, nek- en rugmasserings. Die dames het dit baie geniet om vir 'n verandering die kliënte te wees!

CHALLENGES

In a specialised school such as Sonitus, aggravating factors are attributed to learners. This means for instance that 25 learners are counted when there are five hearing-impaired learners in a class. This factor has implications for the number of posts available, and especially for the fact that learners with special educational needs require additional attention. A learner with a specific learning problem is weighted at 3, an autistic child at 6, a severely intellectually disabled child at 3, and a child classified as mild to moderately intellectually disabled at 2,5.

NATUURLIKE TALENT

Leerders neem jaarliks deel aan die ATKV-kunswedstryd vir spesiale skole. Die leerders dra gedigte voor, die verstandelik erg gestremde groep het 'n gebaretaalooptriede aangebied, en 'n graad 11-leerder, Jennica van der Sandt, het haar eie gedig aan die beoordelaars voorgedra.

59 leerders het deelgeneem in die voordragafdeling en 23 het kunstukke ingedien. Die leerders se kunstukke het besondere talent geopenbaar. Die natuurlike talente van leerders kom hier na vore omdat ons slegs tot by graad 9 Skeppende Kuns as 'n vak aanbied.



Soms neem dissipline-uitdagings ook tyd in beslag en word akademietyd ingeboet om eers rustigheid in 'n klas te bewerkstellig. Elke leerder wat hul persoonlike probleme skool toe bring, beïnvloed die dag se verrigtinge.

Our classes are smaller and there is limited space available. These factors are not always taken into account by the Department.

Sonitus was privileged to obtain three additional posts for the past year. Unfortunately the processes of filling posts are difficult, and some learners were without teachers for long periods. The database of the Gauteng Department of Education, which is used for applications, provides limited information. There are many applications but few from Afrikaans-speaking candidates.

The posts that were approved for the year were withdrawn for 2026, which increased the staff's workload, due to the fact that the school's governing board cannot fund any more posts. Posts are allocated according to the number of learners, and Sonitus admitted fewer "weighted" learners in 2025. Because there is only one Afrikaans and one English class per grade, the staff must teach in several grades, sometimes also more than two subjects.

Sonitus's nurse of the past nine years, Sister Salome Gower, died in a car accident in June. We will miss her voice and her boisterous laugh for a long time to come.

UIT- EN INSTAPPIES

Die VLR het hul jaar afgesluit met 'n informele geleentheid by Acrobranch Adventure, terwyl die VEG-leerders 'n heerlike afsluiting met waterspele geniet het.

SKOONSKIP OOR DIE WENSTREEP

By die Buitengewone Onderwys Interskolebyeenkoms het Sonitus opnuut die eerste plek behaal. Harde werk van personeel en leerders, asook toewyding tydens oefensessies, is deurslaggewend vir so 'n prestasie.

Min leerders neem aan sport deel, maar ons probeer wel om verskeie sportaktiwiteite te doen om aan die leerders geleenthede te bied. Ons het met sokker begin, tans slegs vir oefening, maar ons sal graag verdere geleenthede vir ons leerders wil ondersoek.

Ons beoog om in 2026 te begin met leerderspanne vir rolbal, waar daar reeds 'n vasgestelde liga bestaan.



FEESVIERINGE EN FONDSINSAMELINGS

Sonitus se Rolbaldag, wat nou vir die derde jaar plaasvind, bied geleentheid om fondse in te samel vir ons behoeftige leerders. Weens die min personeel en beperkte ouerbetrokkenheid is daar min geleenthede vir fondsinsamelings.

Ons hou elke twee jaar ons Damesdag en het in 2025 ons formaat verander. Ons het 'n oggendgeleentheid aangebied met 'n mini-kosmark waar dames iets te ete en te drink kon koop en heerlik in die buitelig saam met vriendinne kon sit en kuier. Hierdie jaar se geleentheid was 'n vertoning van Nataniël, wat die lagspiere behoorlik laat werk het.

Aan die einde van September het ons ons Revue aangebied. Die leerders het hul heupswaai-talente op die verhoog gewys. Op die ritme van verskillende Suid-Afrikaanse musiekgenres het ons Trots Suid-Afrikaans gebly.



DANKIE!

Die impak van TOIBO en hul borge se bydraes kan nie voldoende in woorde omskryf word nie. Ons leerders se kinderlike dankie, diep uit die hart, omskryf dié wat in ons sorg geplaas is se dankbaarheid vir die kos, skryfbehoeftes, klere en toiletware wat elke oom en tannie bydra.

Hierdie prestasie het nie net sy sporttalent bevestig nie, maar ook sy deursettingsvermoë en toewyding.



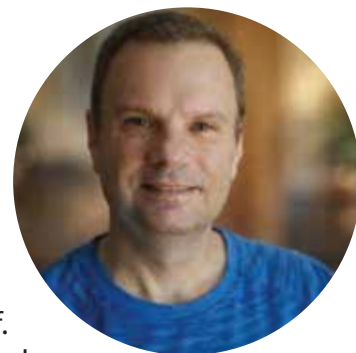

Twee ander skole later en ná ’n draai by die Departement van Onderwys se distrikskantore, het ek my pad teruggevind na Martie du Plessis.

Spelling Competition

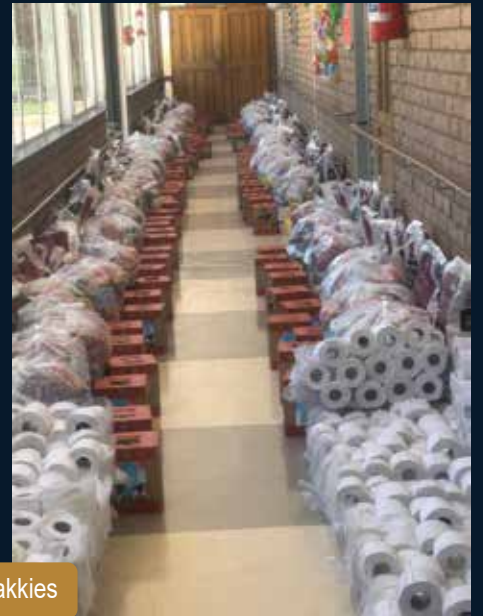

Transoranje huisves leeders van oral in Suid-Afrika. 50% van ons leeders word in die koshuis gehuisves. Ons doel is om die koshuis vir die leeders 'n tweede tuiste te maak. Die Valentynsokkie, 'n pajamapartytjie, 'n modeparade en braaivleisgeleenthede is maar enkele van die aktiwiteite wat deur die koshuis gereël word om die inwoners se tyd weg van die huis vir hulle aangenaam te maak.

HULPDIENTE

Ons beskik oor 'n volledige span professionele terapeute – onder meer 'n opvoedkundige sielkundige, spraakterapeut, audioloog, arbeidsterapeut, maatskaplike werker en twee verpleegsusters. Hulle hanteer elke dag die leerders se onderskeie probleme en is ook verantwoordelik vir verskeie opvoedkundige programme, soos geslagsopleiding, dwelmbewusstheidsprogramme, en vele meer.

Vodacom visited the school on 18 February 2025 to introduce a national relay service to the Deaf. A special WhatsApp group for Deaf people was launched to be used in emergencies.

Throughout the year, audiology and speech therapy students from the University of Pretoria provided therapy at our school as part of their practical training. With their input, more learners could receive therapy, in addition to that given by our two therapists.

Not only the learners received attention. BLS Medical provided evacuation training, first aid training, fire marshall training and health and safety training for 62 of our staff members.

They shared their perspectives on inclusive education and presented resolutions that they believe Blind SA and other disability empowerment organisations should advocate for in the future. ATHLETICS

Lesedi Maleka proudly represented Prinshof School at the National Gauteng Athletics meeting held in Bloemfontein in April 2025. He was the only learner from Prinshof School to be selected as part of the South African Gauteng Athletics team – a remarkable achievement that reflects his dedication and athletic ability.

Lesedi competed in the 100-meter sprint event, where he showcased outstanding speed and determination, earning a fourth place among strong national competitors. His performance was an inspiration to his peers and a testament to the hard work he invested in his training.



BRILLE CUP

On 2 and 3 June 2025, Wilson Koso and Naledi Gambushe in Grade 5 as well as Onthatile Matlatse in Grade 6 participated in the 2025 Braille Cup that was hosted by the National Council for the Blind in Pretoria. These learners took part in various categories including reading comprehension, creative writing and editing. Onthatile Matlatse and Naledi Gambushe scored 83% and 82% respectively, earning them second and third place, while Wilson Koso scored 71%.

Due to these learners' results, Prinshof School was named the overall winner of the Braille Cup competition. We are proud not only of these learners' progressive Braille skills, but also of the complements the school received for the way in which these learners represented themselves and their school during the competition.



EISTEDDFOD 2025

In 2025, Prinshof School again entered the annual Eisteddfod presented by the Afrikaans Arts Association. Learners participated in the following categories: Recital; Prepared Reading; Art; Vocal; and Instrumental. Our school excelled again, with 10 A++ gold certificates with medals. We did this by writing motivations and affirmations on sticky labels and sticking them on one another. Staff members were reminded that, ultimately, it doesn't matter what the world says, but what our Creator thinks of us.



ENTREPRENEURS' DAY 2025

On 26 September, our school proudly hosted a successful Entrepreneurs' Day, so that the learners could showcase their creativity and business acumen. Stalls were filled with a variety of goods, and the learners enthusiastically applied the entrepreneurial principles they had learned in class.
